Login as the user which is used to start stop process schedulers with psadmin utility.

execute a server config file to set environments

```
PS_SERVER_CFG=$PS_HOME/appserv/prcs/schdulername/psprcs.cfg
```

```
export PS_SERVER_CFG
```

```
cd $PS_HOME/appserv/prcs/
```

```
$PS_HOME/bin/psae -CT ORACLE -CD SID -CO USERID -CP PASSWORD -R RUNCTLID -AI PROCESSNAME -OT 6 -  
OF 14 -FP $PS_HOME/appserv/commandline/
```

or you can put them in a parameter file and execute.

USERID is PeopleSoft User id not Oracle user id.
