Mercury Quality Center " it has many tools including Load Runner for load test and win runner and Astra QuickTest

If you have enough budget, you can go for IBM's TMP Test Suite.

If you want to go for Open source tools, try JMeter by apache.

Some where I read about BADBOY and it is suppose to be free for 5 users.

I suggest download the open source tools first and try them on your sandbox and learn a bit of scripting. You would be able to decide on which would be best for your shop.
